Fees, Rates and Charges: Applicant agrees to abide by and be bound by the District's Rules and Regulations, and to pay fees, rates, tolls and charges established by the District. Fees, rates tolls and charges accrue against the real property of the applicant. The District may suspend or disconnect service to the Applicant when any charge is past due.

The Applicant submits System Development Fee of _____ dollars. For Applications received after Jan. 1, 2003, the fee includes the cost of construction of water and sewer lines from the main to your property, which will include all work associated with installing the water and sewer taps, saddles, 3/4 K copper from the main to curb stop, supply and installation of water meter, and schedule sdr35 sewer pipe from the sewer main to a cleanout at the property line. Insulation will also be installed over the top of the lines for freeze protection. In order for the District to provide service, there must be water and sewer mains adjacent to the property. District fees do not cover the cost of installing service lines from the structure to the cleanout or curb stop. The Applicant shall bear the cost of installing service lines from the structure to the cleanout and curb stop.

Time within which connections must be made: Within two years of the date this application is signed by the District, the Applicant must install service lines from the structure to the cleanout and curb stop. Failure to install service lines shall void this permit and all fees paid shall be forfeited to the District.

Service Availability: Water service is limited by the availability of water. The District does not guarantee an uninterrupted supply of water to the Applicant's premises. Failure of equipment, pipelines, or other utility components may unavoidably disrupt service from time to time.
